
B. Pharm. Admissions - Frequently Asked Questions

What are the eligibility criteria for admission to B.Pharm?

The Eligibility Criteria for admission against Minority seats/Institute level seats is as follows:

Candidate should be an Indian National and should possess basic qualification Viz.

- Candidates who have passed 10+2 examinations with Physics, Chemistry, Maths (PCM) or Physics, Chemistry, Biology (PCB) or Physics, Chemistry, Maths & Biology are admitted to the 4-year bachelors program level (Bachelor of Pharmacy or B.Pharm).

What is the admission procedure for B.Pharm?

Out of total admissions at B. Pharm (i.e. 60), about 80% admissions are done through Centralised Admission Procedure run by State Govt. on the basis of AIEEE and MH-CET score. The MH-CET test is conducted by the Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai. The centralized admissions are done by DTE, Mumbai, having website www.dte.org.in Remaining 20% admissions are done by the Management at the Institute level on the basis of MH-CET and H.S.C. results.

What is MH-CET?

Government of Maharashtra shall conduct a single combined “Common Entrance Test” **MHT-CET-2009** for all **Health Sciences, Engineering and Pharmacy** degree courses for the academic year 2009-2010. What are the criteria for applying for a Minority Seat?

In case of Minority seats, the candidates should belong to the minority community/ group for which the institute has secured minority status.

Which University is the institute affiliated to?

H.K. College of Pharmacy is affiliated to the University of Mumbai.

Is the Institute approved by AICTE?

Yes, the Institute is approved by AICTE, Govt. of India and DTE, Govt. of Maharashtra.

Does the Institute have a minority status?

Yes, H.K. College of Pharmacy is a HINDI linguistic minority Institute.

What certificates have to be attached along with the application form?

The Certificates to be attached along with the application form are as follows:

- HSC Marklist and Passing Certificate
- SSC Marklist and Passing Certificate

- CET score card
- Birth certificate
- Leaving Certificate
- In case leaving certificate is not available
- NOC with bonafied certificate
- For GAP (Students taking admission after appearing 1/2/3 years after HSC)
- GAP Certificate Affidavit
- Minority Affidavit
- Minority Certificate/ Affidavit against the admission of minority seat.
- Please submit Xerox copies of each certificate along with 7 passport size photographs.

What is to be done after filling the application form?

Upon filling the form, the same has to be submitted at the office with two recent passport size photographs. After a review of your submitted form you will then be called in for an interview.

What is Dual Specialization & whether it is permitted?

Dual Specialization means Specialization in one major area and minor specialization in another area. No, Mumbai University does not permit dual specialization.
