Attention of the Directors, Mumbai University Institute of Chemical Technology and the Principals of the affiliated colleges in Pharmacy is hereby invited to the provision of the admission criteria of Ordinances relating to the admission for the First Year Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm.) degree course vide pamphlet No.187 and they are hereby informed that the Ag.Vice-Chancellor in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under Section 14(7) of the Maharashtra Universities Act 1994, on behalf of the Academic Council has approved the changed eligibility admission criteria mentioned in the letter No.10/ADG/ADM/2004/1128 dated 13th August, 2004 received from the I/c Joint Director, Higher & Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai, for the year 2004-2005.

Passed H.S.C. (Std. XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent Examination with

- ◆ English as one of the subjects
- ◆ All the subjects mentioned under Group I and
- ◆ Any one of the subjects from group II

AND

50% 45% sche

Secured minimum 50% marks (45% for backward class candidates from Maharashtra) in Physics, Chemistry and the subject of maximum marks amongst the four subjects of Group II added together.

Group - I (All the subjects from this group are compulsory)

1. Physics
2. Chemistry

Group - II (Any one of the subjects from this group)

1. Mathematics
2. Biology
3. Bio-technology
4. Computer Science

They are, therefore, requested to admit the students for the B.Pharm. degree course for the academic year 2004-2005 only as per the above mentioned criteria.
