

the MHAD (Disposal of Land) Regulation 1982.
Ref:- Your letter dated 15.2.06.

Sir,

In accordance with the provisions of the MHAD (Disposal of Land) Regulation 1982 a plot bearing CTS No.1 admeasuring 5900 sq.mtrs. at Oshiwara has been allotted to your Society. Out of 5900 sq.mtrs. permission for utilising 4000 sq.mtrs. area for the purpose of higher education has been given to you by charging necessary charges. The Lease Agreement has been executed for this plot on 9th June,1998 for the period of 30 years. As per Clause 6 of the Lease Deed there is a provision for renewal of Lease Agreement. As per the policy of the Authority after completion of 30 years lease period same will be extended twice for a period of 30 years by obtaining permission from the Competent Authority on normal terms and conditions. Authority reserves the right of increasing Lease premium after 30 years.

Kindly note that as per the terms and conditions of the above Lease Deed period will be extended for 30 years twice.
